## **Top Highlights in Dalarna**

### **Cultural & Historical Sites**

1. **Falu Gruva (Falun Mine)** – A UNESCO World Heritage Site. Take an underground tour and explore Sweden's industrial heritage.
2. **Carl Larsson-gården (Sundborn)** – Visit the home of painter Carl Larsson, a national treasure in art and design.
3. **Zorn Museum & Gammelgården (Mora)** – Showcasing the art and lifestyle of Anders Zorn, one of Sweden's greatest painters.

6. **Tällberg Village** – A beautifully preserved hilltop village with traditional wooden architecture and lake views.
7. **Njupeskär Waterfall (Fulufjället National Park)** – Sweden's highest waterfall; excellent hiking in pristine wilderness.
8. **Styggforsen Nature Reserve** – A magical waterfall in a mossy gorge near Boda Kyrkby.

9. **Nusnäs – Dala Horse Factories** – Watch artisans carve and paint traditional Dala horses at Nils Olsson and Grannas workshops.

10. **Leksands Hemslöjd** – Handicraft shop for quality textiles, ceramics, and woodwork in a cultural setting.

### Festivals & Seasonal Experiences

11. **Midsummer Celebrations** – Dalarna hosts some of Sweden's most authentic Midsummer festivals, especially in Leksand, Rättvik, and Tällberg (late June).

12. **Rättvik Classic Car Week (Summer)** – A beloved car and nostalgia event.

13. **Dala-Floda or Orsa Summer Markets** – Rural charm, crafts, and local foods.

### Winter Attractions (Seasonal)

14. **Orsa Grönklitt** – Skiing, dog sledding, and snowshoeing in winter. Wildlife park in other seasons.

15. **Sälen** – One of Sweden's largest ski areas; also the starting point of the Vasaloppet.
